Master of Education in Educational Management

Objectives

At the end of the program, graduate will have:

1. A board understanding in educational management applicable to the benefit of educational institution in both national and international levels.
2. A strong leadership and managerial skills to contribute toward the effectiveness and success of the organizations.
3. Ability to apply research skills to explore solutions or solve problems through research development process.

Admission Requirements

1. A candidate must hold a Bachelor's degree with a GPA of no less than 2.50 and/or 2 years of work experiences.



2. A candidates must pass the English Proficiency Examination administered by the Faculty of Graduate Studies, Mahidol University or have a TOEFL score of no less than 500.
3. Exceptions to the above items may be made by the Program Committee

Curriculum Structure

Doctor of Education in Educational Management

Objectives

At the end of the program, the graduate will be able to :

1. Apply transformational leadership in managing educational problems.
2. Have knowledge and skills in educational management toward changes in ASEAN and World Communities.
3. Apply advanced research techniques for academic development in international education management.

Admission Requirements

1. A candidate must hold a Master's degree in education or any related field, with a GPA of no less than 3.50 or have a minimum of 3 years of professional experiences in the related field.
2. A candidate must have a TOEFL score of at least 500, TOEFL computer-based score of 173, TOEFL Internet-based score of 61, or IELTS score of 5.
3. Those who have completed a Master's degree without thesis must submit an equivalent qualified paper.
